



FIEC - some basics



- "'Ambassador" for members' interests to EU institutions, based on close cooperation with member federations
- Complementarity with EC,
 i.e. interests in Europe (FIEC) and outside of Europe (EIC)
 i.e. "defensive" interests (FIEC) and "offensive" interests (EIC)
- Joint WGs in areas of complementary know how, incl. coordination with local contractors' associations concerned
- Recognised "Social Partner" (just confirmed by EC study) with possibility to negotiate agreements EU law
- 80 % of national law is based on EU law





FIEC current activities (ECO)



- Juncker Investment Plan EFSI
 - "European Fund for Strategic Investment"
 - → normal EIB procedures (via commercial banks)
 - → higher risks acceptable, without endangering EIB "AAA" status
 - → min. 25 million \(\neq\) project (otherwise regrouping of smaller ones)
- Market Access instrument ("reciprocity")
 - → new attempt for "leverage" in international trade negotiations
 - → EC internal draft text almost complete
 - → LUX Presidency might "test the water", NL Pres. not interested
 - → Will not avoid "COVEC situations"
 - → Spain: "reciprocity confirmation" by embassy for 3rd country firms

FIEC current activities (SOC & Social Dialogue)



- Assessment of all Health & Safety legislation
 - → Psycho-social risks ("stress")
 - → Musculo-Skeletal Disorders
 - → Nano-technology used in material/ products
 - → Respirable Crystalline Silica (inclusion in Carcinogens Dir. possible)
- ""Mobility package", incl. possible modifications of
 - → the "Posting" Directive
 - → the Regulation for coordination of national social security systems
- Fight against undeclared work
 - → European platform being created (EC/ EP/ Council)
 - → incl. "Social Partners" of sectors most concerned (construction)
- Single-member private limited liability company (SUP)

FIEC current activities (TEC)



- Execution Standards
 - → risk that CEN standards increasingly concern installation/ execution,
 - → this would lead to the contractor's responsibility, not the producer's
- Future EU standardisation policy
 - → EC Communication
 - → EC intends to use standardisation for all areas (ECO/ SOC/ TEC)
- Label for resource efficiency of buildings
 - → risk of additional assessment procedures to be done by contractors
- Circular Economy Package/ Waste Directives
 - > recycling/ reuse of construction material
 - → recycled/ reused material must be "fit for purpose"

FIEC current activities (EC "Construction 2020")



- "Strategy for the sustainable competitiveness of the construction sector and its enterprises"
- High Level Tripartite Strategic Forum
- Thematic Groups
 - → 1 "Stimulating investment in building renovation, infra., innovation"
 - → 2 "Skills and qualifications"
 - → 3 "Improving resource efficiency, environmental performance and business opportunities"
 - → 4 "Strengthening the Internal Market for Construction"
 - → 5 "International competitiveness" (EIC and FIEC)
- Studies: services directive, "fitness check"

FIEC current activities (Joint FIEC/ EIC WG "Poland")



- Sejm, Infrastructure Commission,
 sub-commission "roads" hearing 30/9/2015
 - → FIEC/ EIC, NL organisation C.R.O.W. and National Contracting Forum (NCF)
 - positive reactions from chair who will not be in next Sejm.
 - > needs pressure also via Polish ambassadors invited to meet national Ministers
- "21 demands for sound project management"
 - → initial draft with 18 "golden principles" circulated to WG for input
- Transport Commissioner Bulc's response
 - → direct responsibility for CEF-financed "Via Baltica" lots in PL
- Involvement of local contractors' associations
 - → general issue for all Central and Eastern European countries

FIEC current activities (Joint FIEC/ EIC WG "ethics")



- ISO ant-corruption management standard
 - FIEC "liaison" status, PC/278, FIEC/ EIC representative: Per Nielsen
 - draft being finalised, for voting by National Standardisation Institutions
- CoST (Construction Sector Transparency Initiative)
 - initially UK initiative, aimed at developing countries
 - first contacts for extension to EU level
 - FIEC/ EIC representative in CoST review advisory panel: Frank Kehlenbach
- European Economic and Social Committee
 - CCMI/ 132: "Fighting Corruption" (UP in Study Group) adopted, Plenary 16/9/2015
 - main success: request for fair/ balanced contract conditions
