<b>Lockdown</b>	The <a href="#">Honduran Government had ordered the public and private sector (other than food chain industry, supermarkets, gas stations and pharmacies) to an absolute shutdown</a> (cf. Grimaldi Alliance) (April 2020).	The <a href="#">Honduran Chamber of Construction (CHICO) was dealing with the Government to allow for a gradual reactivation of the construction industry's works</a> in rural areas for road maintenance. In this regard the CHICO has developed a guidance note to comply with the instruction of a gradual reactivation of construction activities.
