What are International PPP Standards?

- Evidence based, simple to use, non-mandatory guidance for policy makers
- Based on PPP best practices from a variety of countries (including extensive materials from the IFIs on PPPs)
- To be used as broad templates that will be adapted to fit national peculiarities
- With a focus on transition and developing countries

Why International PPP Standards?

- Governments need clear, authoritative information on the best models to do PPP.
- To date they have national best practices and are forced to choose which models and often they make the wrong choices
- Overall, international PPP standards : Lower transaction costs and barriers to entry, thereby assisting local consultants and advisors in PPP which can help adapt standards to local conditions
- General recognition that we need to do better with guidance and PPP capacity building

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

- 17 goals to eradicate extreme poverty by 2030**
- Focus on increasing access to essential services (health , water and sanitation, education, broadband and internet etc.**
- USD Trillions needed to close the infrastructure gap !**
- Partnerships are the way forward – as set out in SDG 17**

Goal 1: *End poverty in all its forms everywhere.*

Goal 3: *Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages.*

Goal 4: *Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all.*

Goal 5: *Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls.*

Goal 6: *Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all.*

Goal 7: *Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all.*

Goal 8: *Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all.*

Goal 11: *Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable.*

Goal 17: *Strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize the global partnership for sustainable development.*

- Incorporating PPP into Health Policy Framework (pending soon)**
- A mechanism to incentivise governments to comply with the Charter through a certification scheme (pending soon)**
- Procurement, Renewable Energy, Water & Sanitation and Transport (just started)**
